# **About the Roundhouse Aquarium**

The **Roundhouse Aquarium** is a historical and educational landmark located in the heart of Manhattan Beach, California, and serves as a gateway to understanding and appreciating the marine life and habitats of Southern California. Managed by Oceanographic Teaching Stations, Inc. (OTS), a nonprofit dedicated to oceanic and environmental education, the aquarium inspires more than 300,000 visitors annually through immersive, hands-on experiences and science-based programs. The aquarium's renovation, made possible through a partnership with the Harrison Greenberg Foundation (HGF), the city of Manhattan Beach, and the community, ensures its legacy as a hub for environmental education and conservation.

# **Explore Our Exhibits**

Step inside and immerse yourself in the diverse marine ecosystems of Southern California! Our exhibits feature a range of fascinating ocean life, including:

- Tide Pool Tank: Get hands-on and connect with tide pool creatures, including sea stars and urchins
- Moon Jellies: A beautiful display of these translucent animals, showcasing their graceful movement
- **Kelp Forest Exhibit:** Explore the dynamic edge of a kelp forest, where rocky terrain meets sandy shores, and discover the diverse life that thrives here

The aquarium's exhibits are designed to foster a deeper understanding of marine life while encouraging visitors to take action in protecting our oceans and coastal environments.
